On the evening of October 25th, 1961, twenty-three Eagle Rock residents gathered in the foyer of the Women’s Twentieth Century Club to discuss the potential for the organization of a local historical society.

A substantial archive was gathered from surviving pioneers and a museum was opened in the old city hall.

City hall was remodeled and the archive was transferred to the old library, now known as the Center for the Arts, Eagle Rock .

Our focus became the organization and preservation of the legacy left from our founders. The collection was organized by our volunteers and the work of digitally indexing the many items began. At the same time the storage of these rare items was upgraded to archival standards.

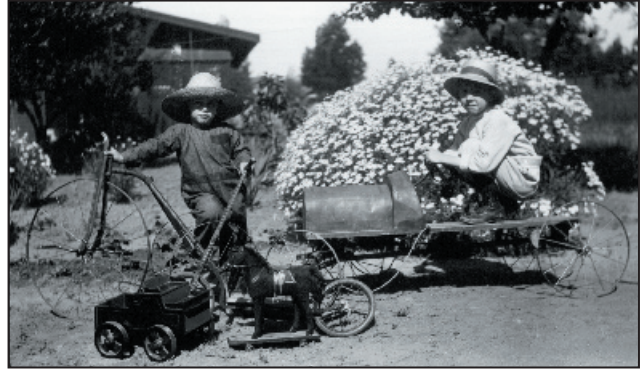
